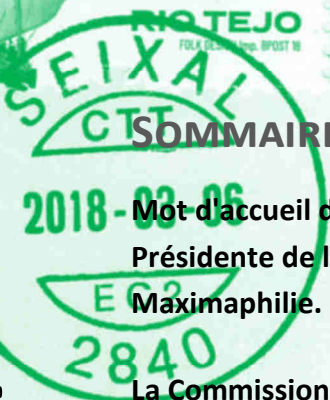

Greetings to Everyone!

It has been a very busy year for us – we have been to exhibitions in Dubai, Prague, Macao, a NZ National in Dunedin, and Bangkok.

The Best Maxi card 2017 Competition was well supported with the winner being France, second was Italy and third equal Finland and Greece.

At THAILAND 2018 in Bangkok there was a Maximaphily Commission meeting which was very well attended. After ‘greetings’ and a roll call we discussed the changes to the SREVs and Guidelines – simplifying the Guidelines and incorporating the SREVs into the Guidelines. Apart from one minor addition in the new Article 3.5 – Variant cards, second bullet point, by adding ‘normally’ everyone approved their acceptance. The next step is to send them to FIP for Board approval early in 2019.

We then had a Powerpoint presentation – cards displayed with everyone asked to decide if they were acceptable maxi cards or not. Everyone participated and copies of the presentation sent to those who requested them.

THAILAND 2018 – there were 5 entries (all of 5 frames) which gained 2 Large Vermeil and 3 Large Silver awards. Entries were from France - 2, one each from Slovenia, USA and New Zealand.

STOCKHOLMIA 2019 - May 29th – June 2nd – there will be a Maximaphily seminar – exact date/time to be announced.

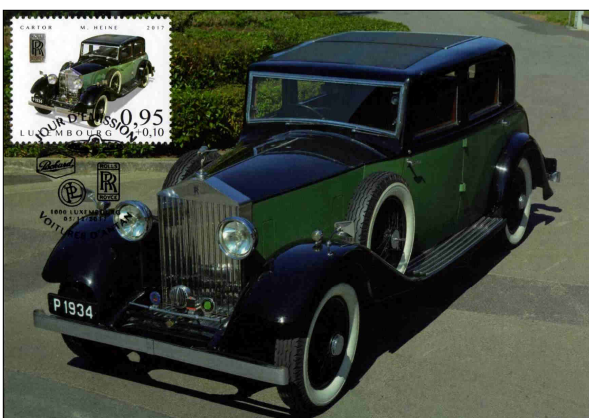
CHINA 2019 – Good news – the Maximaphily class is included. Please encourage your exhibitors to enter.

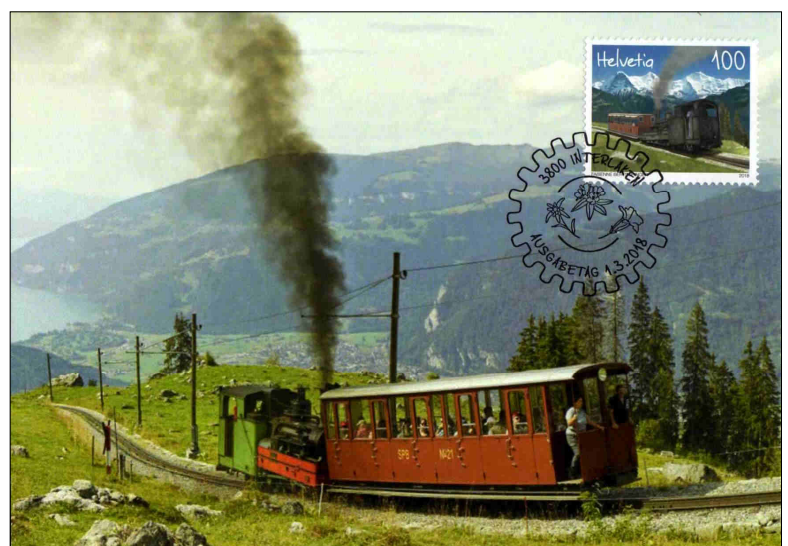
My Best Wishes for 2019 – I look forward to seeing you and your exhibits at CHINA 2019 June.

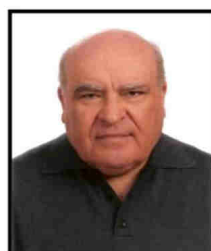

MAXIMAPHILY SEMINAR "MAXIMAPHILY, EASY OR DIFFICULT COLLECTING?"

During the celebration of the XIV AFINET Convention, held in the city of Granada Luis Peris, member of the board of ASEMA, and partner of AFINET, on Saturday, September 15, gave the seminar "MAXIMAPHILY, EASY OR DIFFICULT COLLECTING?", In one of the rooms of the Palace of the Counts of Gaba, of the Diputación of Granada.

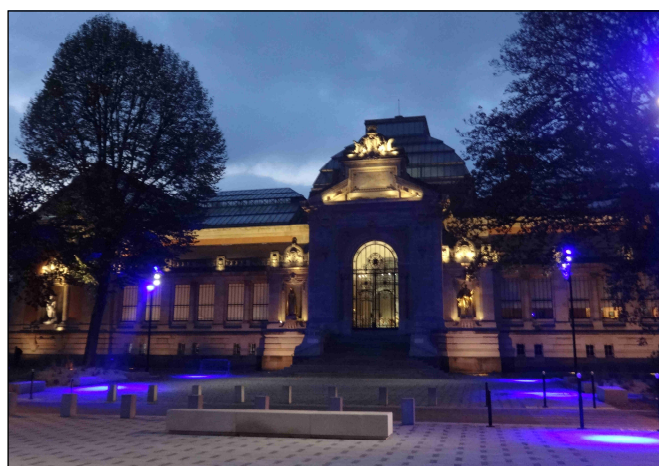

Italie - Italy

In 2018 our Association -AIM- has created 39 MC of Italy and 16 of the Vatican; personal creations have also been numerous.

National Exhibitions: in April in Borgo Fatti -1 frame- : 9 participants (2LV, 1G). In May in Verona -1 frame- Exhibition dedicated to the theme Music: 5 participants (1G).

In October: International Exhibition "Alpen Adria" in Croatia: 4 participants (1LV, 2 G)

In November in Verona "Italy 2018": International competitive exhibition, divided in three parts:

1- National Exhibition. In maximaphily 7 participants (5 LV, 2 G).

2- International Exhibition of Philatelic Literature (both paper and digital). AIM has participated with the Notiziario (photo) and website.

3- International Exhibition "The Great War" (of Postal History, Traditional Philately, Thematic Philatelic and MAXIMAPHILY. The Italian collection "The First World War" has been given Gold .

Gianfranco Poggi wrote an article in the magazine of Federation of Italian Philatelic Society -with the high circulation -about the maximaphily rules also making use of its collection "The First World War" .

Italy took part in the 2018 World Best MC Competition and he has obtained the second place.

Maximafilia e prima guerra mondiale

Maximum di guerra

Qui Filatelia si è occupata più volte di maximafilia, la specialità collezionistica in cui vi deve essere la massima concordanza possibile fra la vignetta del francobollo, la cartolina su cui questo è applicato (dal lato veduta) e l'annullo che lo oblitera. Oggi presenta alcuni esempi del delegato internazionale, soprattutto su temi della prima guerra mondiale, che la Federazione commemorerà a Verona con Italia 2018.

Un francobollo, due soggetti

Per una collezione di cartoline maximum si parte dal francobollo, poi si cerca una cartolina concordante, infine si completa con l'annullo, che deve anch'esso rispondere a criteri di concordanza di luogo e di tempo. La maximafilia assume quindi tre tipi di collezionismo: la filatelia, la cartofilia e la marcofilia. Di solito, naturalmente, queste cartoline non sono viaggiate; è ben vero che si collezionano anche le maximum del primo Novecento, viaggiate e realizzate casualmente, ma sono poche e rare. Allora perché collezionare cartoline maximum? Oltre al piacere di collezionare ciò che piace, ovviamente, la maximafilia permette di chiarire il soggetto del francobollo, a volte di difficile comprensione. Questo esempio è particolarmente efficace: riguarda una maximum relativa alla **Legione tricolore** francese. Il francobollo era stato emesso nel 1942 dallo Stato francese, la Francia collaborazionista di Vichy, che propagandava l'arruolamento nella Legione francese destinata a combattere in Unione Sovietica a fianco dei tedeschi. In primo piano nel francobollo vi è un legionario, sullo sfondo i granatieri di Napoleone. Con lo stesso francobollo, esiste anche un'altra maximum, con supporto una cartolina riprodotte il dipinto di Yvon, conservato a Versailles *Ritirata di Russia, Dicembre 1812*. Questa maximum, che in un primo tempo mi aveva lasciato perplesso, chiarisce molto bene il significato del **soggetto secondario**: la guerra contro i bolscevichi voleva essere per i francesi anche la rivincita della sconfitta napoleonica subita dai russi.




Qui Filatelia

Possiamo ora ricordare le caratteristiche di una maximum. Il formato deve essere conforme alle normative delle amministrazioni postali; l'illustrazione deve concordare con il soggetto del francobollo, o con uno di loro nel caso ce ne siano diversi. Deve essere, preferibilmente, di edizione commerciale; in mancanza sono ammesse edizioni private purché riproducenti un documento (ossia un soggetto, un'immagine) già esistente prima dell'emissione del francobollo. Cosa sono le **edizioni private**? Sono edizioni di associazioni, di ditte filateliche, di singoli collezionisti; ma non hanno lo stesso pregio delle edizioni di commercio. Se sono **cartoline d'epoca**, meglio. Non sono ammesse cartoline che riproducano il bozzetto del francobollo. La prima maximum è **in regola** perché non riproduce il bozzetto del francobollo, bensì il manifesto di propaganda per l'arruolamento nella Legione tricolore. Essendoci due soggetti nel francobollo sono stata realizzate due maximum. Presento ora qualche altro esempio, da una collezione sulla prima guerra mondiale che ho ultimamente terminato. Ecco una maximum che mostra **George Clemenceau**, statista francese, antitedesco, sostenitore della guerra. L'annullo primo giorno è di **Parigi**, città dove è vissuto ed è morto. Nel francobollo ci sono due soggetti: il politico e la corazzata che prese il suo nome. Con due soggetti possono essere realizzate **altrettante** maximum, e questa è una delle due possibili.



La concordanza di luogo

L'annullo deve essere di una località concordante, ossia che abbia un rapporto col francobollo. Oggi sono diffusi gli annulli illustrati giorno di emissione che facilitano il compito di chi realizza, ma non sempre sono corretti. Consideriamo due realizzazioni con i francobolli italiani per il centenario della prima guerra mondiale. L'annullo giorno di emissione della maximum di **Francesco Baracca** è perfettamente concordante, perché Nervesa della Battaglia è la località dove l'asso dell'aviazione morì.



Qui Filatelia

L'annullo di Venezia è corretto: i MAS della dannuziana beffa di Buccari partirono da Venezia.

Ancora: una maximum realizzata con il francobollo del 40¢ della battaglia di Verdun, correttamente ha l'annullo di Verdun.

Al contrario la maximum che mostra soldati stunitisi durante la seconda battaglia della Marna, con francobollo degli Stati Uniti, pur interessante, non è valida, perché priva della concordanza di luogo.

La concordanza di tempo

L'annullo deve avere anche una concordanza di tempo. Cioè: ovviamente una maximum deve essere realizzata necessariamente con un francobollo che abbia validità di affrancatura. È maggiormente apprezzato un annullo ottenuto nel periodo che va dall'emissione al ritiro della vendita del francobollo. Se invece è passato molto tempo l'annullo è considerato ritardatario, ossia mediocre, a meno che non si tratti

Quella in basso, invece, è stata realizzata con un francobollo francese personalizzato che mostra il primo combattimento aereo della storia, avvenuto fra un aereo francese e uno tedesco il 5 ottobre 1914. L'annullo, con perfetta concordanza anche di luogo, è del 5 ottobre 2014.

di un annullo che per l'illustrazione o il testo abbia un rapporto molto stretto col francobollo. È il caso della maximum qui in alto, realizzata con il francobollo della Porte chaussée di Verdun emesso nel 1939, con un annullo illustrato perfettamente concordante Congresso nazionale combattenti di Verdun 5/6/1949. Anche se di dieci anni successiva all'emissione, la maximum è particolarmente apprezzabile.

La concordanza di tempo è massima quando la data corrisponde all'anniversario dell'avvenimento o del personaggio, come per esempio in questa a lato, che raffigura il vagone in cui fu firmato l'armistizio tra Francia e Germania l'11 novembre 1918: l'annullo è dell'11 novembre 1978.

L'uso dei personalizzati

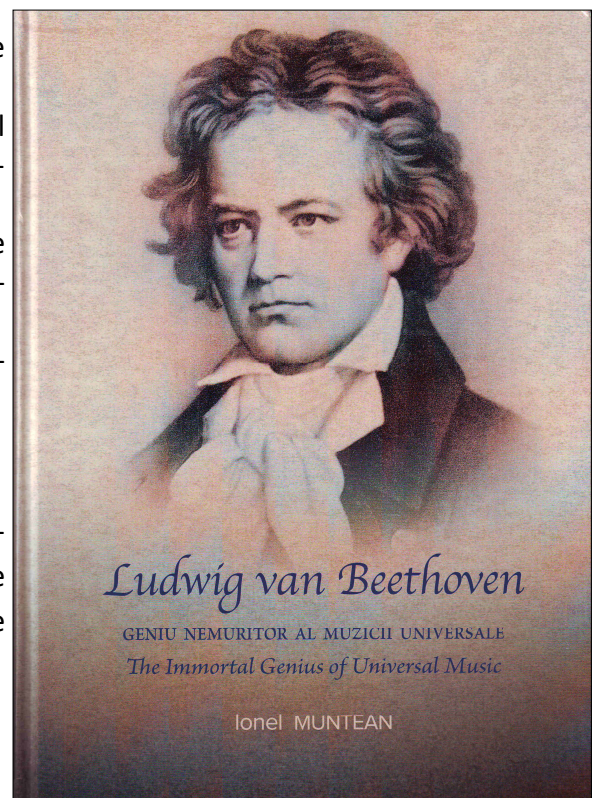
Sortie cette année, à Berlin du livre de maximaphilie sur le thème de la musique:

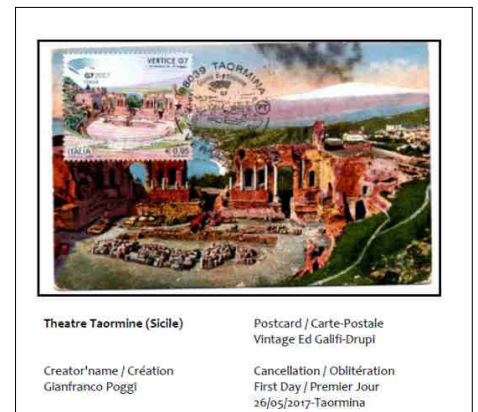

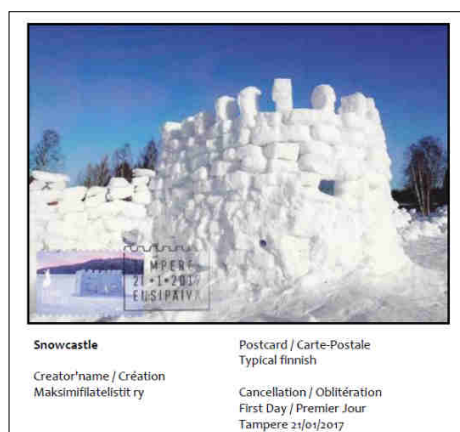

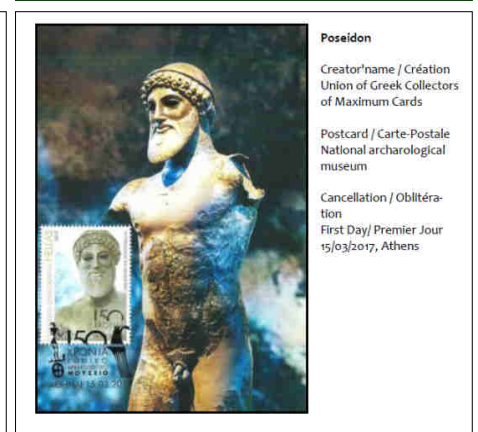

"History of and advances made in medicine"

AESCULAPIUS
A Greek God and son of Apollo and Coronis – his name means "to cut open".



Aesculapius was apprenticed to a centaur Chiron who was widely recognised as an authority on medicine and the use of herbs.

Card: Ampuria Museum, Spain. Card shows the Statue of Aesculapius found in the Greek temple. Museum card.

Stamp: issued 28.6.2007 – history series.

Postmark: First Day of Issue – special cancel with head of Aesculapius

Aesculapius is known to have healed many people.

HIPPOCRATES of COS 460-370 BCE
Born of an Asclepiad (medical) family – he trained first with his father and then later in Athens. He was the **first person to separate medicine from theology**, recording that illness was the result of an imbalance of one of the four body fluids.

The original **Hippocratic Oath** began with: **"I swear by Apollo the Physician and by Aesculapius, Hygieia and Panacea"**. Hygieia and Panacea were daughters of Aesculapius. Modern doctors still recite the Hippocratic Oath.

Card: Privately produced.

Stamp issued 1947 to celebrate the restoration of the Dodecanese Islands to Greece. His birthplace of Cos is one of the Dodecanese Islands.


Postmark: Athens, where he trained.



MIDDLE EAST MEDICINE

Physicians in Mesopotamia introduced many new ideas into medicine – concepts of diagnosis, of prognosis and medical ethics and laws relating to medical practice. The Lode of Hammurabi (king of Babylon in C.18 BCE) stated that if a patient died while a doctor was opening an abscess the doctor's hands were to be cut off but if the patient was a slave the doctor had to supply a replacement slave.

AVICENNA or IBN SINA 980-1037 One of the greatest of Arab physicians. Born in Afshana, near Bukhara, then part of the Persian Empire. He wrote **100 books on medicine** including the **"Diagnostic Handbook"** written 1069-1046 BCE. He became head of Baghdad Hospital, and he accurately described diseases such as Anthrax and Diabetes Mellitus.



Card: La Philatelle Artistique, Nice

Stamp: Issued 12.11.2005 for 1025th anniversary of Avicenna's birth.

Postmark: First day of issue – shows an image of one of his books.


Card: Arab physicians from a 13th Century manuscript. Card printed for "The Islamic Cultural Editions".

Stamp: Issued 29.7.1963 for the 2nd Arab Physicians Union Conference, Algiers.

Postmark: Algiers where the Conference was held.



LEARNING FROM THE DEAD **André VESALIUS 1514-1564**



Card: 'Nets' card by Ern. Thill, Brussels.

Stamp: Issued 15.5.1942. Part of a set depicting famous people. 5c surcharge for fighting Tuberculosis.

Postmark: First Day of Issue, Brussels where he was born.

Vesalius was born into a family of physicians and pharmacists. Studied medicine in Paris and Padua where he developed his great interest in anatomy.


He stole a body hanging from a wayside gibbet – from this he reconstructed a skeleton which made him think that some of Galen's teaching was not correct.

In 1539 he "obtained" a large supply of cadavers and from dissecting them he wrote the book **"De Humanis Corporis"**. He made many enemies through contesting Galen's work. He went to Spain to become doctor to Emperor Charles V.

Card: Shows a drawing by artist Jan van Calcar as in "De Humanis Corporis". Published by Clube Nacional de Maximaphilia, Portugal.


Stamp: Issued 21.4.2014 showing part of a skeleton.

Postmark: First Day of Issue special cancel for 500th anniversary of his birth.



1. EARLY MEDICINE **The Gods**

APOLLO – 5th Century BCE Son of Zeus – one of the Olympians – God of Healing and Patron of Medicine.



Card: Mosaic shown was discovered 1963 in Cyprus. It shows Apollo with his lyre and the barbarian Marsyas who had challenged Apollo to a music contest and lost. He is shown being dragged away to be flogged while a pupil begs for his life. Card printed and published by Mona Ltd, Limassol.

Stamp: Issued 6.1.1991.

Postmark: First Day of Issue.


Mercury (Roman) – Hermes (Greek)
Said to have invented the lyre which he gave to Apollo who gave Hermes the caduceus – a staff with entwined snakes – the **emblem of the medical profession**. He is the patron saint of Pharmacists. Also, the name is the origin of 'hermetically sealed' as pharmacists sealed their medicine jars.

His son's body became fused with a maiden – hence the word 'hermaphrodite'.

Card: French - No publisher.

Stamp: Issued 24.6.1939 showing Mercury and the caduceus.

Postmark: Special cancel September 1943 shows a dove carrying a letter – Mercury was also a messenger for the Gods.

Les frères Lumière :
Auguste Lumière (1862-1954) et son frère Louis Lumière (1864-1948), nés à Besançon, rêvent de reproduire le mouvement de la vie. Ils mirent au point, le 22 mars 1885, le Cinématographe, appareil permettant à la fois de prendre et de projeter un film. Leur premier film, l'entrée d'un train en gare était tellement réaliste pour l'époque, que les spectateurs furent de la salle en craignant d'être écrasés par le train.

II - Le muet américain

Stan Laurel et Olivier Hardy :
Entre 1927 et 1928, Laurel (1890-1965) et Hardy (1892-1957) tournèrent environ 24 courts-métrages muets qui furent célèbres par l'aspect comique et hétéroclite du duo. En 1929, ce fut l'année de transition, ils se mirent à faire des films dont une version était muette, et l'autre sonore (musique et bruitage) et parlante. Ils commencèrent à faire des longs-métrages parlant entre 1930 et 1945, tel que "The Bullfighter", "Bellow zero", "The son of the Desert" et "Fra Diavolo".

Buster Keaton

Acteur et réalisateur américain, il avait mis au point un personnage impossible, "l'homme qui ne rit jamais", qui contribua énormément à sa popularité. Son style, parfaitement adapté au muet, ne put que très difficilement s'exprimer au parlant. Parmi ses films, passés à la postérité, il y a "Le mécano de la générale", "La croisière sur Navigator" et "Le roi de la Bière", qui fut son dernier film marquant.

Cinéaste et acteur américain d'origine autrichienne, Von Stroheim (1885-1957) réalisa son premier film en 1919, "Le Passé Partout du diable", puis "Folle des femmes", "La veuve joyeuse" et "Symphonie nuptiale". Il vint en France en 1926, et y tourna son 20ème film, "La grande illusion" en 1937. En 1939, il y tourna aussi "Les disparus de St Agil", "Macao" et "L'Enfer est en jeu". Il est désormais entré en France, à Maurepas (Yvelines).

Lon Chaney :
Acteur et réalisateur américain, Lon Chaney (1883-1930) fait partie des plus grands du muet, roi de l'horreur et des maquillages impossibles, il fut à tour de rôle, "Quasimodo", "Le fantôme de l'Opéra", "l'amiral von Trepitz" et le mystérieux chinois "M. Wu". Il fut aussi homme du monde, gangster et policier. Un film de 1957 lui fut dédié, "The Man of thousand faces" ("l'homme au mille visages"). Il mourut à 47 ans, juste avant de jouer pour le parlant, un remake du "Club des trois".

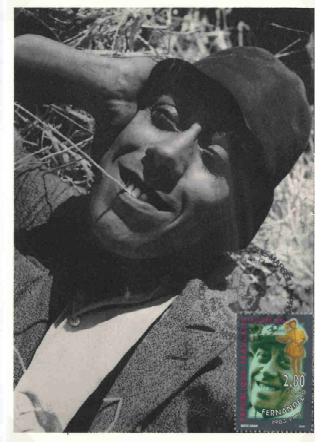
Maurice Chevalier :
